**Committees:** Volunteers needed for Community Relations Committee – Brian Pape has volunteered to Chair this committee and is working on goals to present to the board and then will be looking for volunteers to help reach those goals.

**AIA National:** Daniel Zumwalt went to Grass Roots in Washington DC in early February. Items that were discussed:

1. National has reorganized to a more flat structure. This provides a more current “business” type of structure and helps with better sharing of resources.
2. Top 5 priorities for National are
  - a. Integrated Practice (National BIM standard , GSA BIM guide online).
  - b. Sustainability
  - c. Sustainability tools, public awareness
  - d. Support Citizen Architects
  - e. eKnowledge.
3. AIA to be more active to alert the media of issues that highlight architecture where architects can or have provided solutions.
4. AIA 150 – The flagship program of AIA 150, the blueprint of America, engages the profession in service to communities across the nation, working collaboratively with government

officials and business leaders, engaging citizens in dialogue, sharing basic community design principals, identifying neighborhood conditions that need improvement, and, along the way, demonstrating the visionary role of architects in creating a better quality of life for all.

5. AIA “America’s Favorite Architecture” top 150 on web. Hits to the website went from 7,000 per day to 20,000 per hour.
6. AIA Layer on Google Earth to launch in April ‘07. Will include “America’s Favorite Architecture” top 150 and more. Firms can add projects thru Sketch-up which a free versions is available for download. Students have been encouraged via a contest to create 3D models of their Universities.

AIA Missouri:

Seth Evans reported that a civil penalties bill is currently in committees in both the state house and senate. Also the annual AIA Missouri meeting is on March 6<sup>th</sup>. RSVP’s are due on March 2<sup>nd</sup>.
